Coaching & Player Development

- Design and deliver age-appropriate training sessions aligned with the club's curriculum and philosophy.
- Teach technical skills, tactical awareness, and physical fitness in a safe, engaging, and structured environment.
- Provide individualized feedback and encouragement to players to enhance their growth and performance.
- Evaluate player progress and contribute to team selections for matches and tournaments.
- Consistently work with players on the Individual Player Development Plans – and lead them in the college recruitment process.
- Lead video analysis sessions with goalkeepers

- Prepare players for competition by instilling club style of play and tactical principles.
- Prepare, manage and coach goalkeepers during matches, ensuring player rotations and substitutions align with development goals.
- Foster a positive game-day atmosphere that encourages sportsmanship and respect for referees, opponents, and teammates.
